Plant Operative



Principal Duties

- The safe operation of mobile plant
- Assisting where necessary with the composting process
- Processing and movement of materials
- Build material windrows
- Assist with setting up and running of shredder and screening machines
- Feed shredder and screening machines with material for process
- Cleaning and sanitising work areas
- Carrying out of daily checks in accordance with company procedures and site working plan
- To co-operate with site management
- To work to health and safety, environmental other standards as they apply to the process
- Maintain Standard Operating Procedures as required
- Work to the site critical control point plan
- Work in a way that does not hinder the composting process
- Work to timescales and deadlines
- Learn the composting process and contribute to the success of the operation

You may at times be required to carry out duties not shown in the outline job description above.

Person Requirements

Candidates for this role should possess the following skills:

- Recognised license or qualification to operate plant, CITB, CPCS, EPIC, NVQ or proof of experience
- A demonstrable period of plant operating experience with one or more of the following - loading shovels, agricultural equipment, combine harvester, tracked shovel or bulldozer, excavator, skid steer loaders, tractor and trailer or other industrial equipment
- Experience of setting up screening or similar processing plant
- Experience of feeding screening or similar processing plant
- The ability to work in a team based environment
- Flexibility and willingness to be involved in all aspects of the operation
- Experience of working in an operation with quality and health and safety systems
- Willing to work either a 06:00-14:00 or 14:00-22:00 shift

In addition:

- The right person for this role should be a team player but have the ability to work well unsupervised, manage their time effectively and be self motivated
- Experience in the waste or utilities industries and a knowledge of waste industry practices would be advantageous
- Knowledge of quality protocols would be an advantage, but full training in the site requirements will be given.
